UConn Health Center on Aging will be interviewing clients from the Acquired Brain Injury waiver program about their experiences with their services. The survey asks questions about the people who are paid to help you, your case manager, access to care, transportation, and things you do.

The survey is confidential – what you have to say will be kept private. It takes about 30 minutes, and family members can assist you if you would like. People are not paid to do the survey. Completing the survey is voluntary. If you decide not to do the survey, none of your services will change.
